

School Board Organization/Board Organizational Meeting

Immediately after July 1, the District Board shall meet to organize for the year as directed in ORS 332.040. The organizational meeting shall consist of, but not be limited to:

1. Election of a Board chairman;
2. Election of a vice-chairman;
3. Provide for a time and place for its regular meeting;
4. Other organizational actions prescribed by law or Board practice.

The following business may be conducted at the organizational meeting:

1. Designation of chief administrative officer;
2. Designate custodian of funds;
3. Designate budget officer;
4. Designate depository of school funds;
5. Designate authority to sign federal programs;
6. Consider new budget committee members;
7. Approve legal counsel if desired.

The following business may be authorized:

1. Purchase of equipment from State Department of General Services;
2. Purchase of excess federal property.

The incumbent Board chairman will preside until a successor is elected, whereupon the successor will assume the chair. In the event no incumbent chairman or vice chairman remains on the Board, or neither is able to continue to serve as an officer, a temporary chairman will be selected to conduct the election.

Actual Conflict of Interest

Unless otherwise provided by law, actual Conflict of interest means any action or decision or recommendation taken that would result in a financial benefit or detriment to self or relatives.

A Board member may not vote lawfully if an actual conflict of interest exists unless a vote is needed to meet a minimum requirement of votes to take official action. However, such a vote does not allow the Board member to participate in any discussion or debate on the issue out of which an actual conflict arises.
