The Bandon School District #54 will make an effort to identify talented and gifted students from special populations such as:

- Cultural and Ethnic Minorities
- Disadvantaged
- Underachieving Gifted
- Disabled Learners

Careful selection of appropriate measures and a collection of behavioral or learning characteristics shall be used.

The Bandon School District #54 Board has established an appeals process for parents to utilize if they are dissatisfied with the identification process of their child for the district program for talented and gifted students and wish to request reconsideration.

- ** As used in this policy, the term parent includes legal guardian or person in a parental relationship. The status and duties of a legal guardian are defined in ORS 126.003 - 126.095. The determination of whether an individual is acting in a parental relationship, for purposes of determining residency, depends on the evaluation of the factors listed in policy GBHA. The determination for other purposes depends on evaluation of those factors and a power of attorney executed pursuant to ORS 126.030.
