

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES PARTICIPATION ACADEMIC STANDARDS

Extracurricular activities participation shall be based on the minimum standards as outlined below. It is the desire of the School Board to have maximum participation of students and at the same time seek high standards of performance.

Extracurricular activities shall include but not be limited to athletics, cheerleading, TAG, knowledge bowl, student government, etc. Exclusions include but shall not be limited to activities for which a grade is given (ie: band and choir), limited open forum clubs (clubs that are related to instruction), and instructional field trips. Teachers and advisors may establish individual academic standards for the excluded activities.

Bandon High School athletes must meet all of the rules, regulations and standards as established by the Oregon School Activities Association (OSAA). Because the School Board believes higher academic standards should be established for extracurricular activities participation, the following procedures shall be enforced

GPA

A minimum GPA standard of 2.0 shall be required of all students while participating in extracurricular activities.

ESTABLISHING INITIAL ELIGIBILITY STATUS

At the beginning of each season or school year (for non-athletic activities) all participants shall be eligible until the next six week grading period. Participants whose grades fall below the minimum GPA standard shall be placed on probation.

MAINTAINING ELIGIBILITY

All participants shall remain eligible if after each regular six week grading period they meet or exceed the minimum GPA standard.

PROBATION

Students on probation may continue participating if they adhere to an individualized plan requiring extra study time.

REINSTATEMENT

Participants who are on probation shall return to regular eligibility status after a regular six week grading period where they meet or exceed the minimum GPA standard.
