ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO CLASSES**

The assignment of students and classes to teachers is the responsibility of the building principal. In all assignments, the student's welfare shall be foremost.

1. Parents shall have the right to discuss student class assignments with building principals and have the right to request placement of their student. Such requests should be made known prior to June first of the school year in question.
2. Any desire to change class assignments during the school year may be discussed with the principal.

Schools offering optional programs shall offer such programs to all students. Final selection of students for a program remains the responsibility of the building principal. The building principal shall be responsible for developing guidelines in the selection of students for optional programs. Guidelines for student selection shall adhere to Oregon Laws and reflect the program goals.

** As used in this policy, the term parent includes legal guardian or person in a parental relationship. The status and duties of a legal guardian are defined in ORS 126.003 - 126.095. The determination of whether an individual is acting in a parental relationship, for purposes of determining residency, depends on the evaluation of the factors listed in policy GBHA. The determination for other purposes depends on evaluation of those factors and a power of attorney executed pursuant to ORS 126.030.
