USE OF DRUGS AND ALCOHOL

The possession, delivery and/or use of illegal and harmful drugs or alcohol, real or imitation, is strictly prohibited. This includes possession, delivery and/or use at school during the regular school day and/or at any district related activity, regardless of time or location and while being transported in district-provided transportation.

Therefore, if a student uses, possesses or delivers alcohol, or any controlled substances, real or imitation, or drug paraphernalia on or about the school grounds, or at any school sponsored activities, a referral will be made to legal authorities and an expulsion from school not to exceed one calendar year will result.

However, for a student's first violation of this policy, the administrator has the option to recommend that the expulsion be reduced to not less than 25 school days if the student and his/her parents/guardians agree to conditions that may include but are not limited to the following:

Conditions:

- Having completed a drug/alcohol assessment by a certified counselor at parent expense
- Sign a release allowing the assessor and the school administration to exchange information regarding student behavior
- Work in cooperation with the school to follow through with the recommendations of the assessment
- Enroll the student in an educational class on substance use and abuse at parent expense
- Serve approved community service
- Alternative Education participation

Failure to complete the conditions set forth in the expulsion will result in the implementation of the original expulsion.

Subsequent violations will result in an automatic expulsion not to exceed one calendar year.
