SUBSTANCE/DRUG ABUSE

Since drug and alcohol use is illegal for students and interferes with both effective learning and the healthy development of students, the district has a fundamental and ethical obligation to prevent drug and alcohol use and maintain a drug-free educational environment.

Substance abuse or the possession, use, sale or supply of any unlawful drug, including drug paraphernalia, or any substance purported to be an unlawful drug on or about the district premises or at any school sponsored activity is prohibited.

The following definitions apply to this policy:

"Substance abuse" means the use of any substance with abuse potential which is toxic, corrosive, an irritant, a strong sensitizer, flammable, combustible, generates or is used to generate pressure, if such substance or mixture of substances is used in a manner that may cause substantial personal injury or severe illness when induced by any means into the human body;

"Unlawful drug" means any drug not prescribed by a licensed medical practitioner;

"Drug paraphernalia" means all equipment, products and materials of any kind which are marketed for the use or designed for the use in manufacturing, compounding, producing, processing, preparing, analyzing, packaging, storing, containing, concealing, injecting, ingesting, inhaling or otherwise inducing a controlled substance or intoxicant into the human body.

Violations of this policy will result in suspension or expulsion from school. Appropriate health and law enforcement agencies may be involved in at least a consultative and investigative capacity. Parents will be notified.

Unlawful delivery of a controlled substance to a student or minor within 1,000 feet of school property is a Class A felony. Punishment is a maximum of 20 years of imprisonment, \$300,000 fine, or both.
