ELIMINATION OF DRUGS AND ALCOHOL ON SCHOOL PREMISES

The district shall publish expectations and develop procedures that eliminate the use of drugs and alcohol on the Bandon School District #54 premises. However, concern for drug and alcohol use extends beyond school premises.

Each year the district shall include in the student/parent handbook clear statements of expectations and consequences should a student use drugs or alcohol on school premises. Students and parents shall be informed that unlawful delivery of a controlled substance to a student or minor within 1,000 feet of school property is a Class A felony. Punishment is a maximum of 20 years of imprisonment, \$100,000 fine, or both.

The district shall record incidents and report the findings to the Board in September of each year.
