HLMS= Harbor Lights Middle School



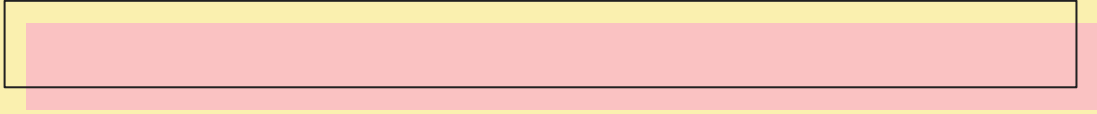
OC= Ocean Crest Elementary School

General Information

All plans are subject to change depending on new guidelines released by ODE.

- School will run **five days a week** (with the exception of holidays and professional development days), pending changes in guidance from ODE.
- Secretaries will order ALL **school supplies** with the exception of backpacks and lunch boxes.

Meals

- Breakfast & Lunch will be **FREE** for all students
- Handwashing protocols **will** continue
- Lunch will be served buffet style in the cafeteria (HLMS & BHS go to district cafeteria), per current guidance.
- BHS Students **MAY** have lunch off-campus
- Adult meal prices are as follows:
 - **Breakfast:** \$2.50
 - **Lunch:** \$4.25

OC: "Grab and Go" breakfast will be eaten in classrooms so building cohorts do not mix

District Wide Covid - 19 Protocols

- **Face masks** will be worn by all people INDOORS only while it is required by the state. **As of 8/13/21, everyone wears a mask indoors whether they are vaccinated or not.** Staff can be maskless in their classroom, if alone. There will not be the potential for mutual agreement between staff to go maskless when students are not present.
 - Clean face masks will be provided daily for all students to wear while indoors. Students will need to wear their personal face masks while on the bus and entering the school.
- **Physical distancing** of 3 feet will be upheld when possible.
- **Handwashing protocols** will remain in place for the foreseeable future.
 - **OC:** Handwashing protocols have been built into the daily schedule.
 - **HLMS & BHS:** Students will wash or sanitize their hands upon entry and exit of the classroom.
- Staff **not yet vaccinated** will need to continue using the **QR codes** for contact tracing.
 - It is up to staff to remain vigilant about the time they spend with other adults in close contact (fewer than 6 feet of social distance for 15+ minutes cumulatively per day).

District Wide Covid - 19 Protocols Continued

- Parents will not be able to walk their child to their classroom at the start of each day due to Covid entry protocols.
- Parents will be allowed to **volunteer** in classrooms, starting in October, as long as they meet the requirements:
 - Wear a mask while in the building,
 - Have a valid vaccination card on file with the front office,
 - Have a completed background check on file with the front office
- **We are not requiring students to be vaccinated.**

Student Health Check-in

(Protocol will remain at the entrances of the school using the Google Form and filled out by building aides.)

Ocean Crest

- Kindergarten enters through the South doors.
- 1st/2nd enter through the main doors.
- 3rd/4th enter through the North doors.

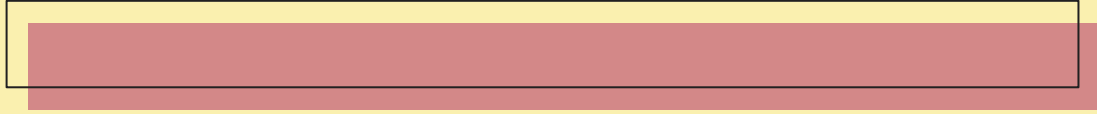
Harbor Lights

- 5th enters at Hambly (Room 5); screening done by 5th Grade Aide.
- 6th enters at classroom doors; screening done in covered hall outside Foster (Room 4) by 6th Grade Aide.
- 7th/8th enters at the main entrance; screening done by building Aide (see Google Sheets schedule for specific assignments).

BHS

- Freshmen and Sophomores enter through the South/Main doors.
- Juniors and Seniors enter through the North doors.

Lunch Cohorts

Ocean Crest

- Each grade will sit on the opposite side of the cafeteria from the other grade.
- There will be a seating chart for the cafeteria to help with contact tracing.
- The cohorts are listed below:
 - Kindergarten
 - 1st/2nd
 - 3rd/4th
- **Recess cohorts** will be the same as the lunch cohorts.

Harbor Lights

- The cohorts are listed below:
 - 5th/6th
 - 7th/8th
- **Recess/Break cohorts** will be the same as the lunch cohorts.

BHS

BHS is **ONE** cohort.

Open campus is still available.

Restroom Cohorts

Harbor Lights

- Students are NOT to be in close contact with each other in the restroom for more than 15 minutes. This will require teachers to be vigilant about students out of the room for bathroom needs.
- The cohorts are listed below:
 - 5th/6th uses bathrooms in the hall outside the HLMS Gym.
 - 7th/8th uses bathrooms in the 7th/8th wing.
 - 7th/8th PE uses bathrooms in the locker rooms - only one boy and one girl at a time.

Ocean Crest

- There will be frequent sanitization of restrooms by grade level aides using the sterophine spray.
- These students will NOT be in close contact with each other in the restroom for more than 15 minutes.
- Aides do not need to spray sterophine after each grade level in the restrooms as they are now a combined cohort.
- Staff need to spray the **sterophine** in the adult restrooms after every use.
- The cohorts are listed below:
 - K/1st in the restrooms by the main office.
 - 2nd/3rd in the restrooms by the cafeteria.
 - 4th/preschool in the restrooms by the playground.

BHS

If families choose to not bring their kids to school, the online program for students is Apex. **BHS teachers will not be providing this instruction.** Apex is making sure all instructors are licensed through TSPC.

- Apex students may take up to TWO classes per semester on campus (but on-campus students get first priority for classes.)

Harbor Lights

Teachers will NOT be responsible for in person *and* distance learning at the same time.

7th-8th Grade students wanting distance learning while we are offering on site instruction will need to choose the Apex option. There is no distance learning option for 5th-6th Grade students through BSD at this time.

Ocean Crest

There will **not** be an online program for K-4 students at this time.

Quarantine Protocols

- If a student tests positive for Covid, only the students within a 3ft radius of that student will have to quarantine (assuming proper masking.) The rest of the class can remain on site.
- There is no more COVID leave available for staff. Illness will require use of accrued sick leave. **Staff and students who are fully vaccinated are not required to quarantine** per current guidance.
- **Seating Charts**
 - **Ocean Crest:**
 - ***Seating charts will be required*** for each classroom and the cafeteria to help with this protocol. The seating charts can change weekly if needed but must be turned into the front office every week.
 - **Harbor Lights and BHS:**
 - ***Seating charts will be required*** for each classroom to help with this protocol. Video footage will be consulted to determine contact tracing needs in the cafeteria. Cameras are pending but will be in soon.

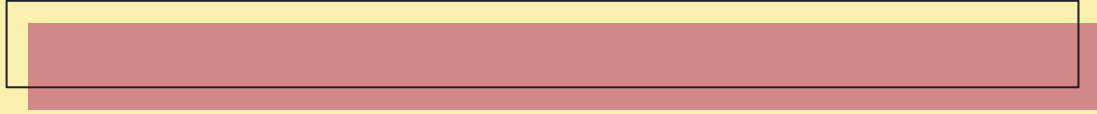

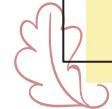
Bussing



Bussing Protocols

- There will not be a limit on end of day **bussing plans** (like last year where each child could only ride one bus all year).
 - Each child's weekly transportation needs must be communicated to the office ahead of time if it will be different from the original plan. Due to bussing cohorts, the Transportation Department will need notice of change at least 5 days in advance, unless there is an emergency.

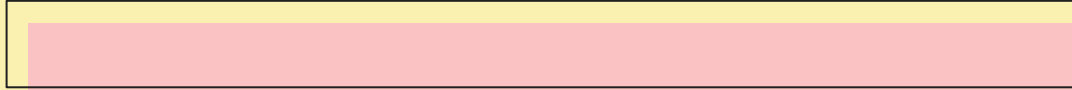
Social Emotional Learning



Social Emotional Learning

- To ensure **safety, wellness**, and the **well-being** of each student, we will use Character Strong for mental and social health.
 - This is a district-wide initiative focusing on Social Emotional Learning.
- **Ocean Crest & HLMS:** This is built into the schedule for every classroom every day.
- **BHS:** This is built into the schedule every Wednesday during Advisory. We will make a plan for how we adjust for regular Advisory activities.

BHS

Seniors may take required courses plus two elective courses (for a half-day schedule) with Work Experience in the afternoon.

Apex students may take up to two courses on campus. On-campus students take precedence for class placement.

- We are offer **EXCITING NEW ELECTIVES** at 7th and 8th Grade including STEM, Robotics, Career Exploration, Logic Games, Geography, Art, and Leadership!
- HLMS will now have 6th Grade students in a self-contained model.
- We have rebranded our mascot and are thrilled to be **TIGERS** with our OC and BHS counterparts!

Ocean Crest

Kindergarten will have one on one family conferences the week of Sept 7th.

- Each family will have a 40 min. block to meet one on one with their Kindergarten teacher.
- All kindergarten students will start together on Sept. 13th.

Music, Library, and PE classes will be reinstated with students leaving their general education classrooms for each of these services.

- Music twice a week, Library twice a week, PE five times a week.
- Cleaning protocols will ensure the limit of potential spread between cohorts.
- Students will sanitize before and after these classes.

Additional Information

- Per Gov. Brown, **all** K-12 staff members must be vaccinated or receive a medical or religious exemption. More information to come.
- We are **not** teaching Critical Race Theory (CRT).
- We are **not** having any vaccination vans or clinics come to our school this year, like they may have in the past.
- We are **not** vaccinating students without parent permission on school grounds.
- We are **not** requiring students to be vaccinated.
