MASK MANDATE LIFTED... admin is working on the updates of the District RSSL

BSD continues to put systems in place so that we follow a plan with goals for how the district can be more efficient and continue to do great things for our students.

District is looking at a potential partnership with the city to continue to find ways to meet the workforce housing issues.

Ms. Belletti has been doing an excellent job for the district with locating additional grants and detailing our programs within the grant system to be what the district is actually doing. There has been a lot of clean up and additional work to help our district to achieve our goal of putting systems in place and being efficient with funding. We hope in the future that we will be able to apply for facility grants for our kitchen, our science labs, and to expand our CTE programs.

Bond committee met and we continue to be on track with projects and spending.

Focus on Student Learning

The district is looking at systems that will enhance our ability to pull student data that will show growth through a K-12 system. The data will also show gaps of learning and help us to address the needs and challenges of all our students and curriculum needs more efficiently. The admin team has looked at the Oregon Data Suite and also NWEA (MAP) testing. We will continue to dig deep into these to see how it can help our students and our K-12 system.

Adoption of Curriculum: This year is ELA. Grades K-6 did their new curriculum this year and the 7-12 plan to add their new curriculum next year.

Adoption for 2023-24 will be Math. K-12 will be looking at the math curriculum next school year to adopt.

Summer Learning: We are looking at how and what we can do for summer learning. ODE has not given the amounts or opened the grants as of yet. We know we will do credit recovery for HS. K-8 we will look at enrichment programs and capability of offerings.

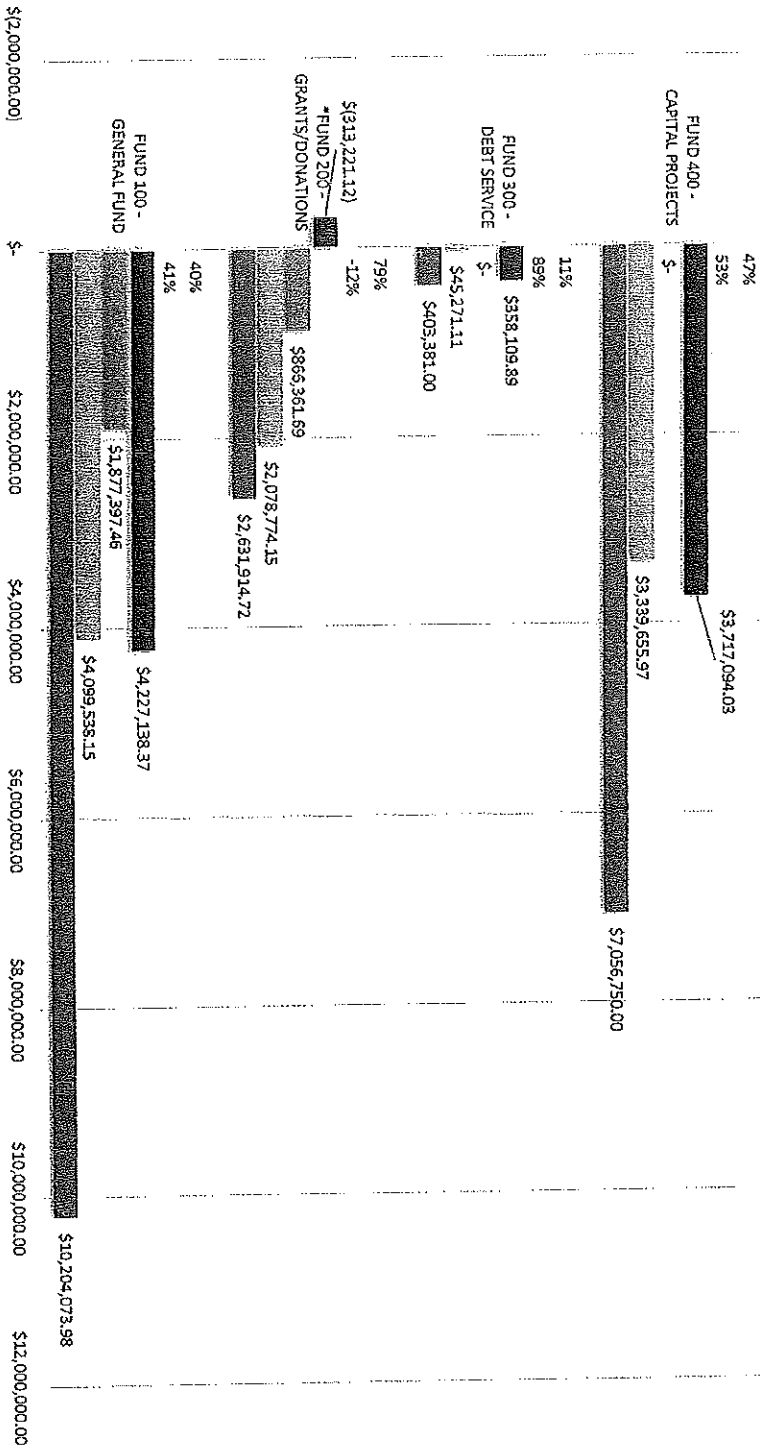

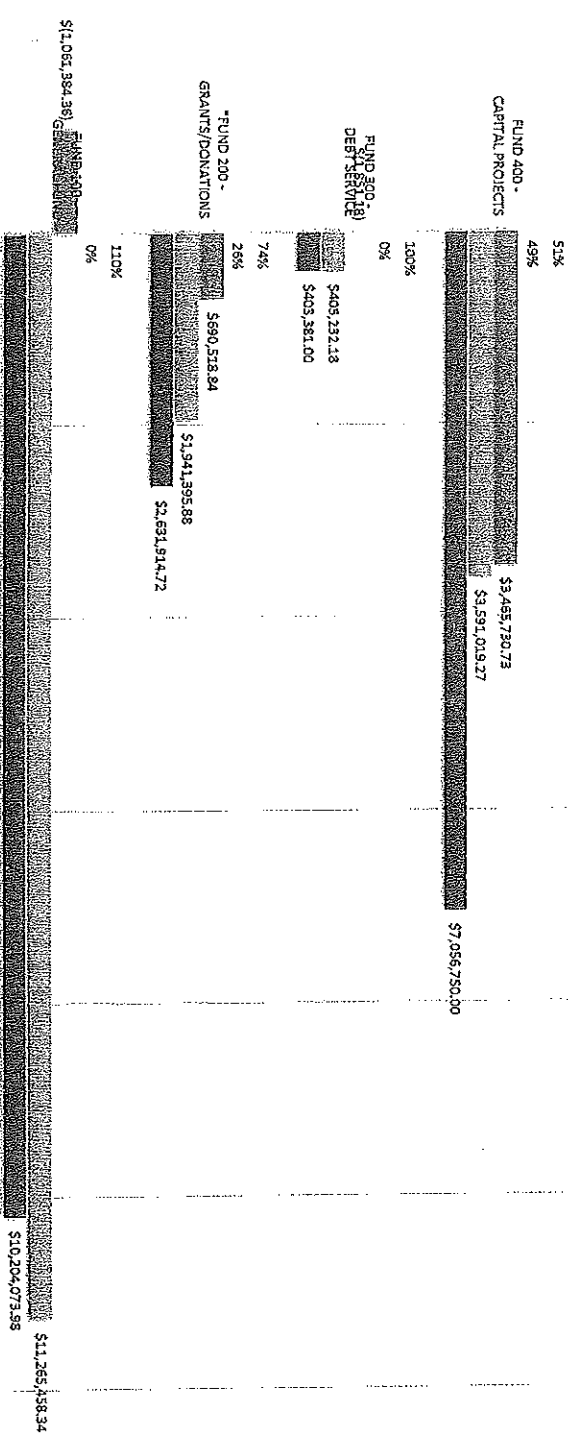

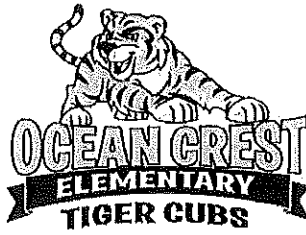
